Eligibility Criteria:

- 1. Candidates must have 12th Pass of any stream, minimum aggregate score of 50% (45% for SC/ST/OBC candidates) on their 10+2 level or equivalent exam in order to be eligible for this certificate course study.
- 2. First come, first served is the policy for admission to this course.
- 3. The Department of Sociology at Mahila Mahavidyalaya Georai is an exception to the rule that most colleges use to choose students: their percentage and tuition structure.
- 4. Since 1989, this institution has served the underprivileged sectors of society and weaker students.

Duration:-

This is a Thirty Days short term certification course that offers an in-depth study of the Women studies. of 50minutes lecture,06 Lecture in one Week.
