Marathi language, Indo-Aryan language of western and central India. Its range extends from north of Mumbai down the western coast past Goa and eastward across the Deccan. In 1966 it became the official language of the state of Maharashtra and co-official language in Goa state. The standard form of speech and writing is that of the city of Pune.

Descended from the Maharastri Prakrit, Marathi has a significant literature. Books are printed in Devanagari script, which is also used for handwriting. Although for handwriting there is also an alternate cursive form of Devanagari called Modi.

As per the 2011 census of India, there were approximately 83 million people claim Marathi as their Mother tongue. Native Marathi speakers form 6.86 % of Indian population. Marathi is included among the language which stands a part of the eighth schedule of the Constitution of India, thus granting it the status of a 'Scheduled Language'. As native speaker, our students can benefit by improving their writing skills for career development.
